#### Introduction

This report provides an overview of the activities, outputs, and dissemination efforts of the K-Peritia working groups for the reporting period October 2023/October 2024. The report is structured chronologically, detailing the contributions of WG 2, including meetings, surveys, brainstorming sessions, webinars, publications, and outreach efforts.

#### 1. Working Group Activities

Working Group 2 (WG2) focused on testing and promoting the Open Access CULTEXP Database during the reporting period from October 2023 to October 2024. The group's primary objective was to enhance understanding, usage, and applications of the database within the network and beyond.

WG2 initiated its activities with a series of preparatory meetings involving both leaders and members. An internal survey was conducted to map the expertise of WG2 members, providing valuable insights for future collaborations and task allocations. The group developed initial use cases and diagrams, laying the groundwork for future database applications. These efforts culminated in the creation of a comprehensive Action Plan for the first year of the program.

At the opening plenary event in Oxford, WG2 members presented their research backgrounds, outlined the objectives and deliverables of WG2, and shared the planned activities for the first year. The group engaged in discussions with other working groups, fostering ideas for crossgroup collaborations.

Given that WG2's objective primarily concerns the Open Access CULTEXP Database, WG2 conducted two key surveys among network members. The first survey, which had a high participation rate, revealed that while 100% of participants were aware of the cultural expertise.net website, less than one-third had used the CULTEXP database. This insight was crucial in shaping the group's subsequent activities. In response, WG2 organized a live demonstration of the CULTEXP database, explaining its features and providing detailed usage instructions. This initiative was well-received by network members and led to increased engagement with the database.

A second survey was conducted to understand potential uses of the CULTEXP database among network members. This survey provided rich data and insights into how different stakeholders might utilize the database in their work. The results helped refine the group's use cases, ensuring that the database development aligned with user needs and expectations across various disciplines and sectors.

A key deliverable of WG2 was the publication of Use-cases booklets demonstrating how various users interact with the Open Access CULTEXP database for research and educational purposes. The first edition, published in March 2024, included six use cases covering diverse fields such as legal education, financial advisory services, social work, human resources, cultural history, and personal relationships. These use cases were carefully crafted to illustrate the practical









applications of the database in real-world scenarios. These use cases were disseminated widely among the members of the network as well as to public though individual LinkedIn posts.

The group continued to develop additional use cases throughout the year. The second edition of the Use-cases booklet – which is under publication – features 10 more use cases, further expanding the range of applications. Further, the WG2 has already finalised the first draft of the third edition of the Use cases booklet, to be published in October 2024 with another 10 use cases. As an important milestone in the work of the working group, this will bring the total to 26 use cases developed within the first year of the Action, thereby providing a comprehensive resource for understanding the diverse applications of the CULTEXP database.

WG2 members participated in and contributed to various training events. Co-leader Sameer Rashid Bhat participated in the COST Academy training on "How to make a scientific research presentation," introducing K-Peritia and WG2's work to participants from other COST Actions. He also offered a training course on "How to introduce Cultural Expertise to an interdisciplinary audience?" at the K-Peritia Training school in Istanbul. WG2 members participated in additional training courses, including one on "How to Publish in Cultural Expertise" led by Dina Haddad (WG1 leader).

Following the Istanbul training, WG2 leader Gokce Nur Yilmaz wrote an insightful blog post that was published on the K-Peritia website. In this blog, Gokce highlighted how WG2 members explored avenues for publication and participation within the framework of cultural expertise during the training. The blog post not only served as a reflection on the training experience but also as a means to disseminate key insights to the broader network and public audience.

Throughout the reporting period, WG2 maintained regular internal online meetings to track activities, gather support from members regarding use-cases and use-case diagrams, and integrate new knowledge into ongoing activities. These meetings ensured continuous progress and collaboration among WG2 members. These meetings were organized in various formats, including one-on-one meetings between the leader and co-leader, as well as full group meetings involving available WG2 members. This flexible approach ensured continuous progress and collaboration, allowing for both focused leadership discussions and broader group input.

Dissemination efforts included the publication of blog posts on the K-Peritia website and LinkedIn posts, sharing published use cases among network members and the general public. These efforts enhanced the visibility and impact of WG2's work on the CULTEXP database and its applications in various fields.

#### 4. Qualitative and Quantitative Analysis

#### 4.1 Qualitative Analysis

**Narrative Summary:** During the reporting period, WG2 focused on enhancing the understanding, usage, and application of the Open Access CULTEXP Database. Key activities centered around developing diverse use cases, promoting database accessibility, and fostering interdisciplinary engagement across various fields.

The group made significant progress in use case development, publishing the first edition of its use-case booklet in March 2024, featuring six comprehensive examples spanning legal education, financial advisory services, social work, human resources, cultural history, and personal relationships. WG2 has since expanded its efforts, with a second edition under publication and a third in draft form. Collectively, these editions will showcase 26 use cases, a significant milestone for the first year.

Efforts to promote database access and awareness were supported by two key surveys. The first highlighted a low usage rate of the CULTEXP database, despite high awareness of the cultural expertise.net website. In response, the group organized a live demonstration, which boosted engagement. A second survey provided deeper insights into potential applications for the database across various stakeholder groups.

WG2 actively participated in interdisciplinary engagement through training events like the COST Academy and K-Peritia Training School in Istanbul. These initiatives introduced cultural expertise concepts to diverse audiences and fostered cross-disciplinary collaborations.

The group's work was further supported by continuous collaboration, with regular internal meetings ensuring consistent progress. Flexible formats, including one-on-one leadership discussions and full group sessions, helped balance focused leadership with broader group input.

In terms of dissemination efforts, the group used platforms like the K-Peritia website, HAL Science and LinkedIn to share updates on the CULTEXP database and its applications, successfully increasing the database's visibility.









Some of the challenges that the group faced were:

- The dominance of legal case studies risked limiting the perceived utility of the database across other fields.
- Maintaining consistent participation across all working group members was difficult.
- Low initial usage of the CULTEXP database required proactive interventions.

The group employed the following successful strategies to overcome these challenges:

- Encouraging participation from non-legal members helped broaden the range of potential use cases.
- Surveys provided valuable feedback, guiding the direction of the use case development.
- Offering flexible contribution opportunities allowed members to engage according to their interests and expertise.
- Mapping member interests helped tailor tasks and responsibilities, increasing overall engagement.
- Live demonstration proved particularly effective in increasing user awareness and understanding of the database.

**Key Insights:** WG2's activities have made a meaningful contribution to expanding the application of the CULTEXP database. The group's iterative approach to development, combined with diverse engagement strategies, has significantly improved the database's visibility and demonstrated its versatility across multiple disciplines. The group's efforts have laid a solid foundation for future applications and improvements.

#### 5. Conclusion

Working Group 2 (WG2) has made substantial progress in its first year, focusing on enhancing the understanding, usage, and applications of the Open Access CULTEXP Database. The group's primary achievement was the development and publication of an extensive collection of use cases, totalling 26 across various disciplines. This accomplishment not only exceeded initial expectations but also significantly expanded the perceived applicability of the database beyond legal contexts.

The group's strategic approach to addressing challenges, particularly the initial low usage rates of the database, proved effective. By conducting targeted surveys and organizing live demonstrations, WG2 successfully increased engagement with the CULTEXP database among network members. These efforts have laid a strong foundation for future database utilization and development.

WG2's participation in training events and cross-disciplinary collaborations has been instrumental in introducing cultural expertise concepts to diverse audiences. This interdisciplinary engagement has enriched the group's work and expanded the potential applications of the CULTEXP database.

The continuous collaboration within the group, facilitated through regular meetings and flexible engagement options, has fostered a productive working environment. This approach has allowed for both focused leadership discussions and broader group input, ensuring comprehensive progress towards the group's objectives.

Dissemination efforts, including blog posts and social media engagement, have effectively increased the visibility of WG2's work and the CULTEXP database. These efforts have contributed to a growing awareness of cultural expertise across various fields.

Moving forward, WG2 should focus on further diversifying use cases beyond the legal domain, maintaining and increasing member engagement, and continuing to improve database accessibility. The group's success in developing a substantial number of use









cases provides a strong platform for future research and applications of cultural expertise.

It is important to acknowledge that while significant progress has been made in developing and expanding the use cases for the CULTEXP database, more effort should be directed towards the publication and dissemination of deliverables in accordance with the WG2 agenda.

The activities and outputs of WG2 have contributed significantly to the advancement of cultural expertise within and beyond the K-Peritia network. While the immediate impact is notable, the groundwork laid through these efforts promises even greater long-term contributions to the field of cultural expertise and its interdisciplinary applications.












#### <u>Survey 2 - Awareness about CULTEXP Database</u>




